

STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

ATTEND FUNERAL (Funeral directors charges only)	£2,280.00
<i>This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.</i>	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements.	£1,019.00
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care.	£250.00
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities.	£250.00
<i>The deceased person will be kept at the funeral directors: C McGough & Sons, Tunstall & Biddulph</i>	£475.00
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from Oak Veneered recycled wood.	£1.00
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director. (where viewing is requested by the Client)	£285.00
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle.	£285.00

UNATTEND FUNERAL	
<i>This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.</i>	
Burial (Funeral Directors charges only)	£1,300.00
Cremation (Funeral Directors charges plus the cremation fee) (2)	£1,400.00

For an Attend or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee(1) In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee or local residents is:	£463.00 - £3,200.00
<i>For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in Place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.</i>	
For an Attend cremation funeral, the cremation fee1 In this local area, the typical cost for cremation for local residents is:	£705.00 - £1,090.00

(1) This fee(which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

(2) In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the medical certificates for Cremation.

SIMPLE CREMATION A Reduced Service

A basic attend funeral including all the necessary services provided by a funeral director. The choice of crematorium and date and time of the cremation service will be at the discretion of the Funeral Director.

The Simple Cremation package includes:

Unattended

The simplest funeral with no mourners, no family attending, no funeral ceremony, hearse direct to a crematorium at an undisclosed location on an undisclosed date and time (within 14 days of cremation paperwork being received by C McGough and Sons Funeral Directors).
